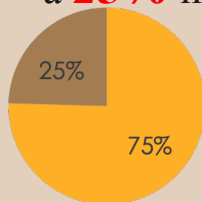

ART THERAPY

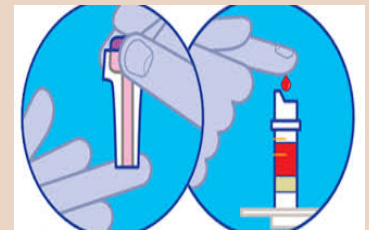
A group of clients meet each week for Art Therapy.

HIV TESTING

In partnership with the Montgomery County Department of Public Health, **16** were able to receive free HIV testing and counseling



Arize Workforce Development Program

23 students graduated the skills training course



15 have achieved and maintained employment since graduation

25 local employers coordinated with Arize to help instruction and networking

9 students were homeless when entering the program

100% have acquired housing and moved off the street



HOLIDAY ASSISTANCE

112 ADULTS and **92 CHILDREN**
